

# Code sheet for DRUGDATA

## **ID**

Unique ID for each entry in the dataset. OP stands for *opium*, COCA for coca bush and C for cannabis.

## **Product**

Coca, opium or cannabis.

## **FIPS**

FIPS code for the country.

## **Country**

Country name

## **Region**

Name for the region(s) in which cultivation occurs

## **Begin**

*Begin* notes the year when more extensive, commercial/export-oriented cultivation started. Obviously, there is no clear-cut year that could denote the exact year for this and, therefore, *Begin* year reported in the dataset stands for the approximated time period commercial cultivation started.

Year 1945 is entered for observations in which cultivation had started prior to 1946.

## **End**

In some cases cultivation has been brought to an end. In these cases the end year is reported. As for the *Begin* year (above) the year stands for the approximate time period that significant cultivation ended (that is, limited cultivation may still occur after that time).

## **Traditional**

*Traditional* notes if the drug plant in question has been traditionally cultivated in the region (for local use) before more commercial production started.

## **Production**

*Production* gives a very rough estimation of the importance of the cultivation region in the global context. Scale: small/middle/large/very large.
